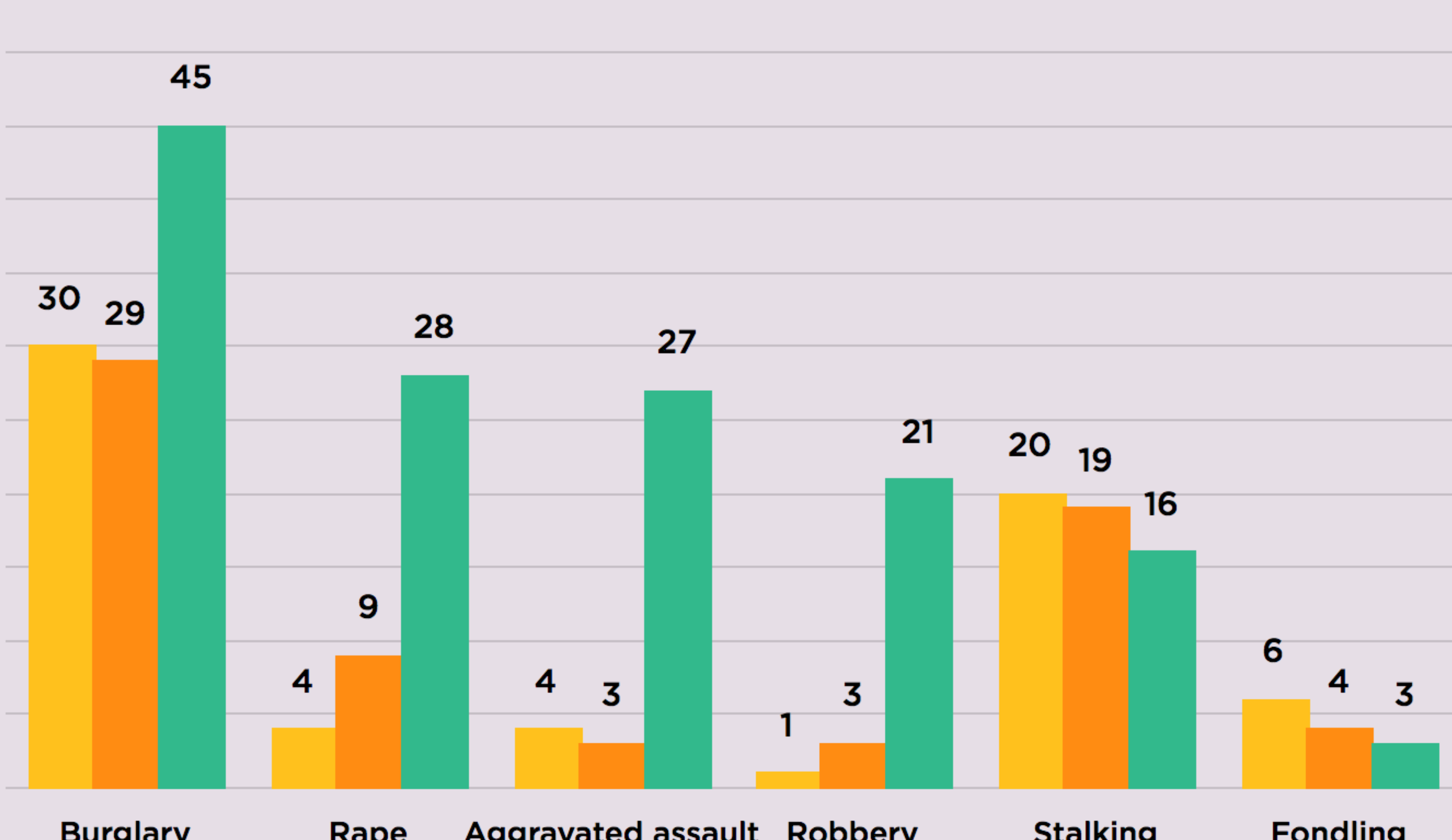

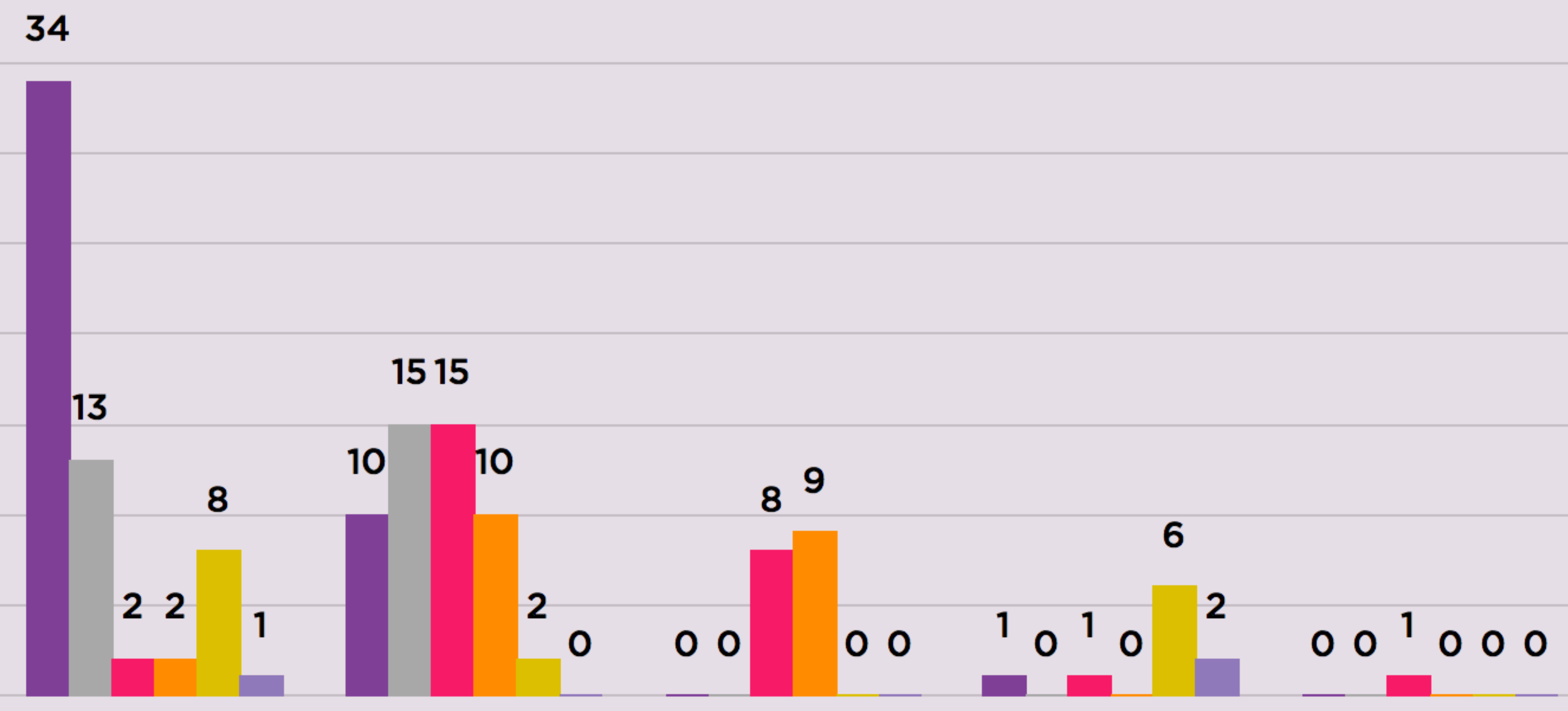
Jeanne Clery, a 19-year-old student at Lehigh University in Bethlehem, Pa, was raped and murdered in her college dormitory in 1986. Shocked at the under-reporting of university crimes, her parents, Connie Clery and Howard Clery, pressed for the first campus safety law in Pennsylvania in 1988. The Campus Security Act, also known as the Clery Act, was passed in 1990.

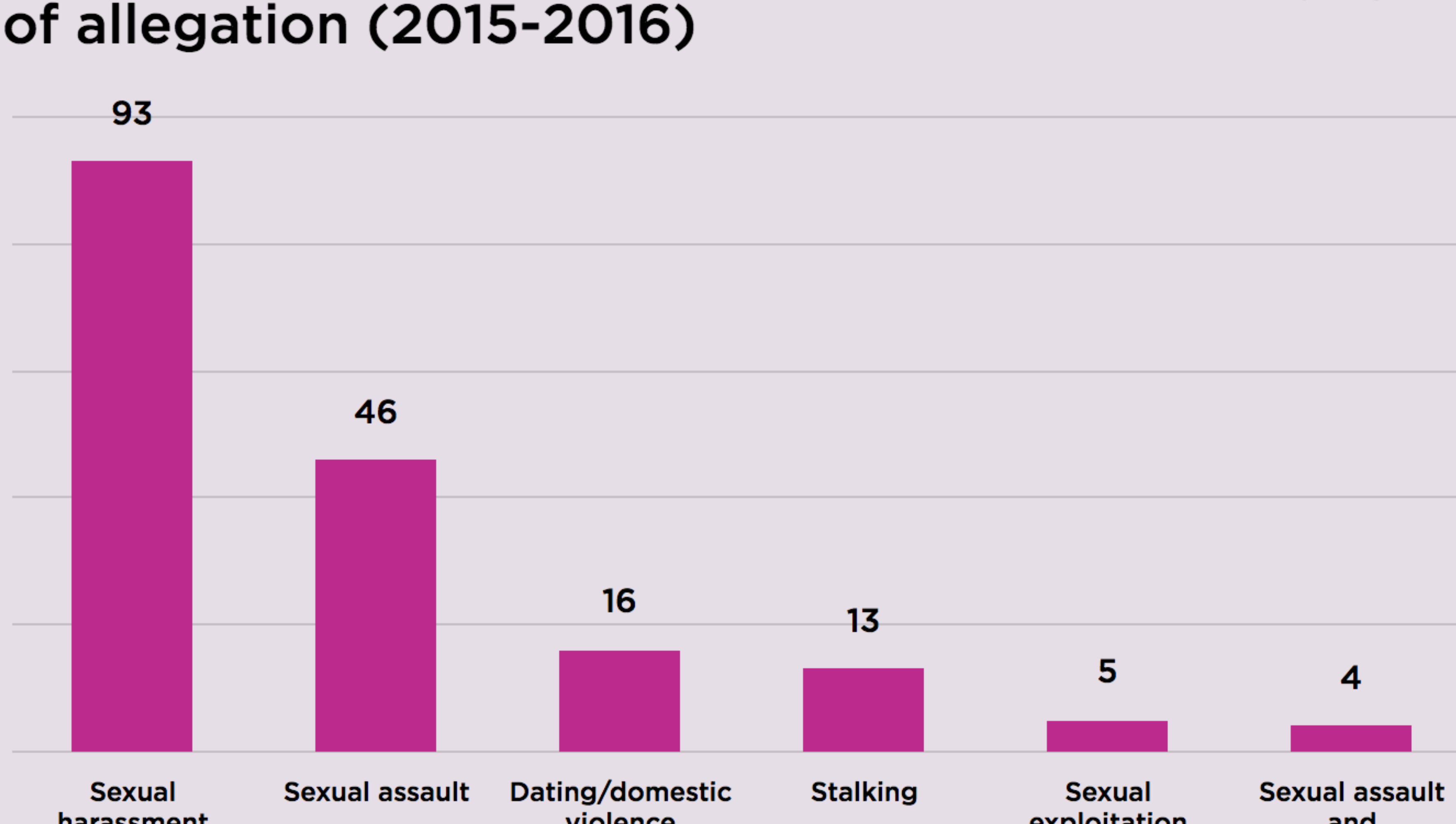

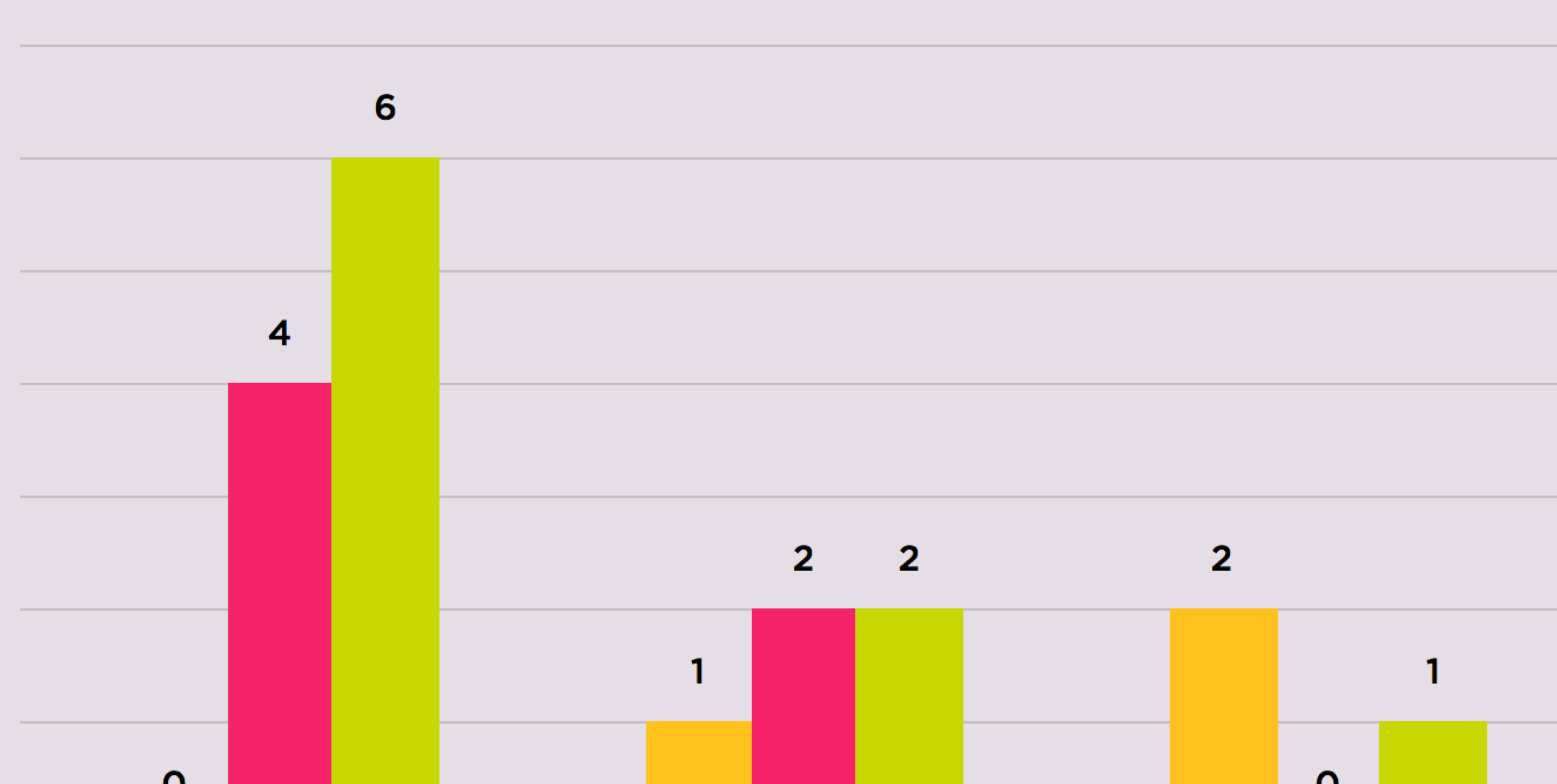

Top 3 crimes reported at EC campuses

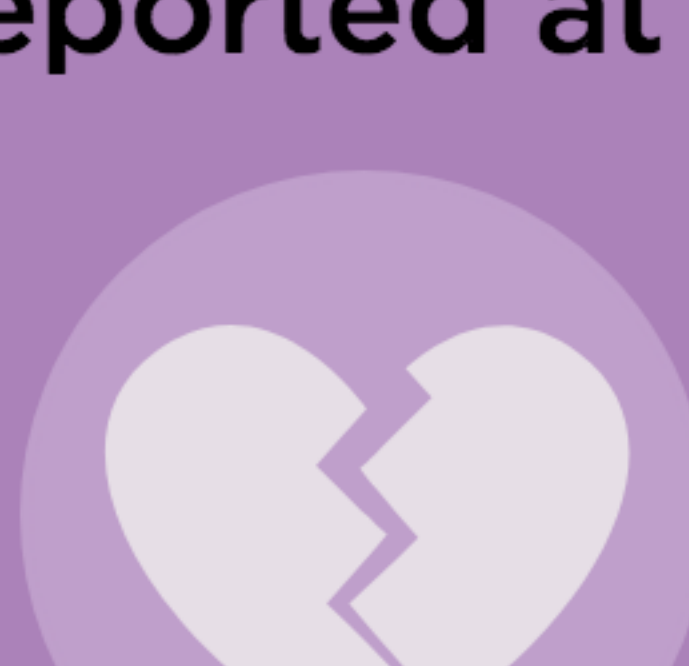
